## CONSISTENCY – NEXT STEPS

- DEFRA to issue its response to the 2021 consistency consultation comments and issue Draft Statutory Guidance, to include ‘commencement dates for separate food waste collections’.



- DEFRA issues its response to the Statutory Guidance consultation and parliamentary scrutiny commences (N.B. Statutory Guidance is ‘secondary legislation’ and needs to be laid before parliament before it can be enacted).



- Only once Statutory Guidance has been passed into law can the Section 31 letters (confirming the New Burdens payments) be issued.

All **waste upholstered domestic seating (WUDS)** must be incinerated from 1 January 2023 after an investigation found large levels of **persistent organic pollutants (POPs)** in seating textiles and foams.

WRAP is creating **new icons** for those waste items that now fall under the new **WUDS POPs** regulations and those waste items that do not.
